This Horizon Europe Research and Innovation Action (RIA) aims to advance European leadership in biotechnology, life sciences and biomanufacturing by developing innovative bio-based and bio-inspired processes, products and materials that support sustainable, circular and competitive value chains. The topic contributes to the EU ambition to strengthen industrial competitiveness, strategic autonomy and decarbonisation through biotechnology-enabled innovation, while generating measurable benefits for climate, biodiversity and resource efficiency.

Funding

The topic is funded as a Horizon Europe Research and Innovation Action (RIA) with an indicative budget of €12 million . The European Commission expects to fund approximately three projects , with indicative contributions of around €4 million per project .
