Objectives

Objectives

This call aims to advance the European Union's understanding of maladaptation in climate adaptation efforts. Eligible entities include research organisations, universities, industry partners, public authorities, and related stakeholders that can form international consortia. The core objective is to systematically retrieve existing evidence and generate new knowledge about maladaptive outcomes in adaptation strategies and integrate these insights into key EU repositories such as Climate-ADAPT. The call targets improvements in risk and adaptation assessment frameworks by addressing maladaptation, providing guidelines and tools for both prevention and correction, and supporting policy and decision-makers at multiple governance levels. The expected impact is to support climate action, close critical knowledge gaps, and strengthen the European Research Area on climate change through excellence, inclusiveness, and synergy with other relevant initiatives.

Funding

Successful proposals will be supported under the Horizon Research and Innovation Actions (HORIZON-RIA) with a total call budget of EUR 18,000,000. Expected EU contribution per funded project ranges from EUR 5,000,000 to EUR 6,000,000. The co-financing rate for eligible costs can reach a maximum of 100%, in line with Horizon Europe rules for research actions. Up to three projects are anticipated to be funded under this topic. Detailed financial and operational conditions can be found in the referenced General Annexes. No minimum project value is set, but proposals must be proportionate and clearly structured, following the application form's instructions.
