## Descrizione

### Objectives

The call aims to facilitate and strengthen collaboration between the Climate Adaptation and Disaster Risk Management communities at European, national, and regional levels. The primary objective is to develop inter- and transdisciplinary approaches for addressing climate adaptation and disaster preparedness, in support of the EU Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change, the Preparedness Union Strategy, and the upcoming European Climate Adaptation Plan. Eligible applicants include consortia of organizations such as academic institutions, research centers, public authorities, and other stakeholders with relevant expertise.

### Project Types

Funded projects should focus on coordination and support activities. Key project types include: establishing joint knowledge and methodological approaches; developing guidelines for risk management policies that integrate climate adaptation; identifying and disseminating relevant solutions and best practices from previous EU-funded projects; implementing multi-governance approaches to spread knowledge via National Adaptation Hubs; and organizing the European Climate Change Adaptation Conferences in 2028 and 2030. Eligible expenses generally cover personnel, travel and subsistence, equipment, other goods and services, and in-kind contributions, provided they are justified in the detailed lump sum budget as required. Specific attention should be given to the proportion of purchase costs relative to personnel costs, and any exceptional items need to be properly justified.

### Funding

The total budget for this call is €5,000,000, with an expected individual EU contribution per project around this figure. Lump sum grants will be provided as per Horizon lump sum rules. The maximum co-funding rate follows Horizon Europe Coordination and Support Actions (CSA) rules, which allow up to 100% funding of eligible costs for all beneficiaries. Only one project is expected to be funded under this topic. There are no explicit minimum or maximum

project value limits apart from the suggested EU contribution, and applicants must adhere to financial and operational capacity requirements.

### Key Aspects

The funded project should deliver specific outputs such as enhanced cooperation frameworks, joint methodologies, tailored guidelines for policy implementation, and the successful hosting of ECCA events. Maximum project duration is not explicitly stated but should align with CSA expectations and event timelines, notably incorporating the organization of conferences in 2028 and 2030. Performance will be evaluated on the basis of effective stakeholder engagement, knowledge dissemination, inclusiveness towards vulnerable regions, and overall advancement of climate adaptation frameworks. Applicants must follow all general and specific conditions described in Horizon Europe Work Programme General Annexes and ensure their proposals comply with the proposal template and budget guidelines provided by the European Commission.
