Objectives

Objectives

This incentive supports the Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities Mission by accelerating the transition toward climate neutrality in cities. The primary objective is to improve energy efficiency in urban and sub-urban public transport systems, alongside urban mobility service car fleets, such as taxis, ride-hailing, car sharing, and other shared mobility services. The focus is on reducing greenhouse gas and air pollutant emissions, enhancing the electrification and attractiveness of transport, and providing cities with practical guidance and new tools for effective integration of innovative mobility solutions. Eligible entities include consortia composed of at least three lead cities from different EU Member States or Associated Countries, one of which must be among the 112 cities selected for the EU Mission on Climate-neutral and Smart Cities, along with three follower cities. The consortium should also integrate academia, local authorities, public transport and mobility service operators, and relevant stakeholders.

Funding

The program provides non-refundable support. Funding rates reach up to 100% for certain entities; differentiated rates may apply as per Horizon Europe rules. Exact co-financing proportions depend on the applicant type, with the maximum funding rate determined by the highest eligible category. Project budgets must enable pilots in at least three lead cities and the inclusion of replication activities and engagement mechanisms for additional cities.
