Objetivos

Objectives

This incentive aims to strengthen the collaboration and integration among research communities across climate and non-climate domains. The main objectives are to develop more comprehensive, robust, and actionable climate scenarios that inform and support optimum policy interventions for diverse stakeholders such as policymakers,

businesses, and civil society. The targeted outcomes include the advancement of climate-resilient development pathways, richer scenario diversity, and stronger representation of equity, justice, and geopolitical aspects in climate modelling. Eligible applicants are typically consortia of research institutions, universities, public organisations, SMEs, and relevant stakeholders demonstrating transdisciplinary approaches along with the inclusion of Social Sciences & Humanities (SSH) expertise.

Funding

Funding is provided under the Horizon Europe Programme as a Research and Innovation Action (RIA). The topic has an indicative budget of €24 million, with the European Commission expecting to fund around six projects. As a result, the indicative EU contribution is approximately €4 million per project. The call follows a single-stage submission process, opening in November 2026 and closing on 4 March 2027. As a Horizon Europe RIA, projects are funded at 100% of eligible costs.
