Descrizione

Objectives

This call aims to support the implementation of the EU Mission on Adaptation to Climate Change and the forthcoming European Climate Adaptation Plan. Eligible applicants consist of established consortia from Member States or associated countries, collaborating with standardisation organisations, finance institutions, end-users, and research entities. The primary objectives are twofold: (1) to advance and consolidate methodologies identifying global and regional reference climate data sets and scenarios, enabling their consistent use among EU Member States for climate adaptation; and (2) to standardise and streamline climate service practices, ensuring improved quality and trustworthiness of services that inform adaptation policies and decisions across diverse sectors and regions in the EU.

Project Types

Eligible projects must deliver innovative, robust methods to select and regularly update reference climate data and scenarios, co-developed with end-users to ensure operational relevance. These methods should integrate quantifiable, traceable approaches leveraging existing data sources such as CMIP, CORDEX, and Destination Earth. Additionally, actions should support the development and demonstration of pilot standardised climate services in adaptation-critical sectors, including but not limited to climate finance, infrastructure, health, agriculture, energy, water management, insurance, and the natural environment, provided these sectors are justified. Typical eligible expenses include personnel, equipment (under lump sum restrictions), travel and subsistence, other goods and services, and collaboration activities with standardisation and mission platforms.

Funding

This call follows the HORIZON-RIA (Research and Innovation Actions) scheme, awarding lump sum grants with an allocated topic budget of €9,186,307.30 and an indicative EU contribution of around €9,000,000 per project. The

expected funding rate is up to 100% of eligible costs. One grant is anticipated under this call. All eligible costs must conform to lump sum grant regulations—detailed cost justification may be required for categories exceeding personnel thresholds.

Key Aspects

Projects funded under this topic are expected to actively engage with the Mission Community of Practice, share relevant knowledge, and collaborate with other Mission Implementation Platform projects. The maximum project duration is typically up to 48 months, according to Horizon Europe norms. Result indicators include enhanced uptake and standardisation of climate services, consistency in data/scenario use, improved quality assurance, increased policy and decision-making effectiveness, and demonstrable links with adaptation objectives of the Paris Agreement. Proposals must incorporate provisions for ongoing operational links with the Mission and allocate sufficient resources and expertise for these obligations.
