## Objectives

### Objectives

This call supports actions under the Clean Energy Transition sub-programme of LIFE, aiming to accelerate the decarbonisation of the industrial sector across EU Member States. Eligible applicants include legal entities such as companies, energy service providers, public authorities, research institutions, and NGOs established in EU or associated countries. Projects should particularly target innovative energy solutions, integration of renewable energy in industry, energy efficiency improvements, and support for the market uptake of relevant clean technologies.

### **Funding**

Funding under this call is in the form of non-refundable grants. The co-financing rate can reach up to 95% for eligible project costs, depending on the type of activity and applicant. The maximum grant contribution per project is 2.000.000€ and will depend on the project scope and relevance to the specific themes. Budgets should be commensurate with the scale and ambition of the proposed work plan.
